What is a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS)?

A Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) is a document that contains information on the use, storage, handling and emergency procedures related to the hazards of the material. Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) regulations require that employers maintain safety information about hazardous chemicals used or present in the workplace. Such knowledge begins with an MSDS.

How do I Obtain an MSDS?

Distributors are responsible for ensuring that their customers are provided a copy of the MSDS. Employers must have an MSDS for each hazardous chemical that they use.
